A particular acknowledgement for Ola Panca that was reviewed by Ottagono on October publication.

Established in 1966, Ottagono has been one of the reference design magazine for more than forty years. Ola panca is a modular bench made of polypropylene (mass coloured with an injection technique and with anti-slip finishing) ideal for the waiting rooms. It is comfortable, functional and, at the same time, elegant in its classical simplicity and it may be easily inserted in any waiting room.

The structure made of 70 mm diam. aluminium grey painted, hosts up to 5 seating with or without armrests and with the possibility to insert a small table with magazine rack. It is available in 5 colours (ivory, anthracite, burgundy, orange and mocha) and the leather version.
